WL Church Family – Donation Ideas for We Care Warsaw

- 1. Gift Cards (or Coupons) or Items for the All Day Door Prizes
 - each guest receives a duplicate door prize ticket; throughout the day door prizes are given.

 The church families donated over \$3,000 in gift cards to local grocery and retail stores last year.
 - Any dollar amount welcome.
 - Examples: (a) Big Box stores such as Wal-mart, K-mart
 - (b) Other stores such as Dollar General, Wal-Greens, CVS
 - (c) Restaurants: any fast food restaurant; family restaurants
 - (d) Grocery Stores such as Owens, Aldi's
 - (e) Car Maintenance/repair shops: such as Auto Zone, any repair shop, gas stations (gas cards).
 - (f) Hair Salons: such as Fiesta (who yearly provide stylists to donate time to cut hair at We Care Warsaw)
- 2. Other suggested donations: (wait for announced date/time to begin drop donations off at the church.)
 - <u>Liquid Laundry Detergent</u> (one bottle will be provided each family unit; as Food Stamps do not cover this item)
 - Manicure Station supplies (Nail polish, polish remover, manicure tools)
 - Small Group or ABF Project ideas:
 - (a) <u>Collect the Supplies for the "Make Your Own Laundry Detergent class.</u> Boxes of 20 Mule Team Borax; Boxes of Arm and Hammer ;Super Washing Soda Bars of Fels Naptha Soap; Containers of Purex Crystals; Set of measuring cups; and Large Gladware
 - (b) <u>Gift Baskets</u> starting this year, gifts baskets will only be accepted that are already assembled /packaged together and of a minimum \$40 value. Ideas include:

<u>Personal Hygiene</u> (shampoo, soap, washcloth, toothbrush, etc.); <u>Kitchen/Cooking</u> (measuring cups kitchen towels, utensils, etc.); Just Add Water (hot chocolate, teas, flavored water packets;

- 3. <u>Provide a service</u> complimentary snacks throughout the day; haircuts; manicures/make-up; samples of a product; etc.
- 4. <u>Coordinate & lead A Self-Help/Self-sufficiency "class"</u> to encourage citizens in ways to do something for themselves. A thirty-minute or less demonstration classes work best. For example: We have had "How To Make Your Own Laundry Detergent Classes" offered all day at every half hour attended by 15-20 each class.
- 5. <u>Provide items for the Christmas Toy Store</u> (children's toys/games, education materials; winter hats/glove-mittens/boots/scarves. New items; no used items)
 - a. only parents enter the gift store
 - b. free gift wrapping is provided
 - c. a nominal price tag is placed on items well below half the actual cost. Proceeds go toward the church's Monthly Gas Card Day where we assist up to 30 families from the community with a \$15/Gas Card; first-come-first-served basis. Why have a cost involved? Studies of community food/clothing banks have shown that a parent's self- esteem is enhanced when they have contributed toward their children's gifts vs. receiving it free.
- 6. Suggest a different opportunity to be involved.
